HISTORY

Situated in the foothills of the Larzac plain, approximately 160m high, the appellation area of Saint Saturnin has a soil mixture mainly of clay and limestone and is particularly abundant in stones. It benefits from a dry climate in summer that limits the yield.

The combination of the latest wine-production techniques with a complete traceability enables us to follow a philosophy based on the care of both the fruit and the land.

Thanks to the investment made each year to ensure the continued improvement of the quality of the wines, the cellar of Saint Saturnin is now established as one of the best cellars in Languedoc-Roussillon.

GEOGRAPHY & SOIL: Situated in the lower foothills of the Southern Larzac high plain

CLIMATE: Mediterranean, very hot

VARIETAL: Cinsault, Grenache, Carignan

TASTING : Your eyes will not resist the softness of the colour. You will experience total pleasure when this wine reveals its aromatic originality on the nose and the palate. With the elegant marriage of exotic fruits and red berries, this wine is a rosé from the new generation, subtle and harmonious.

SUGGESTED DISHES: An ideal accompaniment to fish, salads and pizzas but also as an aperitif.
