The Domaine de la Présidente owns 20 hectares of Côtes du Rhône in the communes of Suze la Rousse and Sainte Cécile les vignes. This blend represents the fruitiness and the balance brought by our different terroirs.



50% Grenache, 35% Syrah,  
10% Carignan, 5% Mourvèdre



Clay soils in Sainte Cécile les Vignes and clay and limestone in Suze la Rousse, with lower yields.



Grape varieties are harvested separately at full maturity.  
Short ageing in concrete and steel tanks.



Red color with purple reflections. Nose of blackcurrant, blackberry, violet and black pepper. The mouth is ample, with silky tannins, flavors of jammy fruit and a nice acidic length.



It will go perfectly with a beef carpaccio, a grilled entrecôte, or grilled ceps.



Ageing potential : 3 to 5 years.

In 1701, Lucrèce, wife of Simon Alexandre, President of the Parliament of Provence, converted the lands of the Domaine de la Présidente into vineyards. Located in the heart of the Rhône Valley, in Sainte-Cécile-les-Vignes, it is today a family estate that covers 137 hectares and includes four appellations: Côtes du Rhône, Côtes du Rhône Villages, Cairanne and Châteauneuf du Pape.
