The Domaine de la Présidente has 3 hectares of white Côtes du Rhône white. This blend represents the balance between the freshness and structure provided by our different terroirs.

Grenache Blanc, Roussanne, Viognier



This wine is made with grapes from parcels of vines located in Suze la Rousse and Sainte Cécile les Vignes, on claylimestone soil.



Grape varieties are harvested separately to adapt the maturities. Long fermentation between 61 and 64°F. Four months aging in concrete and stainless steel tanks with stirring.



Light yellow colour with green highlights. A nose of yellow fruits like plum and apricot, associated with citrus zest. The mouth is fresh and mineral with a touch of bitterness and acidulous in length.



Aperitif, liver pâté, starters with raw vegetables, fish and seafood.



Ageing potential: 2 to 3 years.



Serving temperature: 12° C / 54° F.





In 1701, Lucrèce, wife of Simon Alexandre, President of the Parliament of Provence, converted the lands of the Domaine de la Présidente into vineyards. Located in the in the heart of the Rhone Valley, in Sainte-Cécile-les-Vignes, it is today a family estate that covers 137 hectares and includes four appellations: Côtes du Rhône, Côtes du Rhône Villages, Cairanne and Châteauneuf du Pape.
